LIABILITY: Everyone attending the sale does so at their own responsibility and risk and without liability on the part of Dockweiler Angus or their employees.

INSPECTION: The cattle may be seen any time prior to the sale at the ranch. We will have the cattle available for inspection at the Dawes County Fair grounds by 10:00 AM the day of the sale.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Lots 1 - 52 sell WITHOUT registration transfer. We will be happy to provide registration transfer on these lots for an additional \$50. Please add this to the purchase price and leave instructions with the clerk.

Lots 53-56 sell WITH registration transfer as part of the purchase price.

REFRESHMENTS: Complimentary coffee and donuts in the morning with lunch at noon.

SALE: We will have all the sale cattle on site at the Dawes County Fairgrounds for your inspection. We will not bring the cattle into the sale area. Instead we will play a video clip of each lot as it is being auctioned off. Warren Mitchell will take bids for us again this year. He will accept bids in the order that he recognizes them and will progress in \$100 increments starting at the Base Price listed in the catalog.

ABSENTEE BIDDING: If you are unable to attend, contact us and we will work out a way for you to participate that you are comfortable with. Rest assured that your absentee bid will not be misused in any way and your satisfaction upon delivery is guaranteed 100%.

GUARANTEE: We expect that our selection and development of these bulls has provided an excellent product that in most cases will breed more cows for more years than bulls produced from other development and selection criteria. November is a perfect time to mix new bulls into your bull battery while the breeding season is over and the ground is not yet frozen. Turn these bulls out with your other bulls, keep them from frost damage, and maintain them in reasonable condition and we will guarantee them to semen test in the spring before turnout should you decide to do so. Beyond that there is no guarantee against injury or death and they do become your property at the time they are sold.

WINTERING: We realize that paying for and taking possession of new bulls in November may not fit all operations. Therefore we are prepared to offer a service whereby we winter the bulls for you under the following terms:

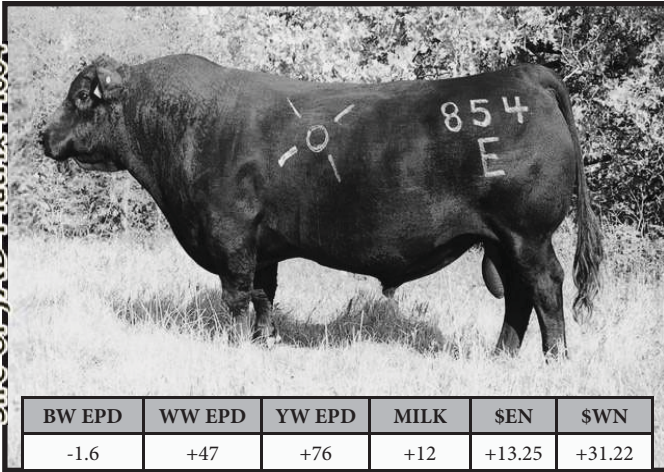

He was an exceptionally quiet bull that you could walk up to and scratch any time any place and his progeny display that same disposition. Extra is deceased and semen is not available.

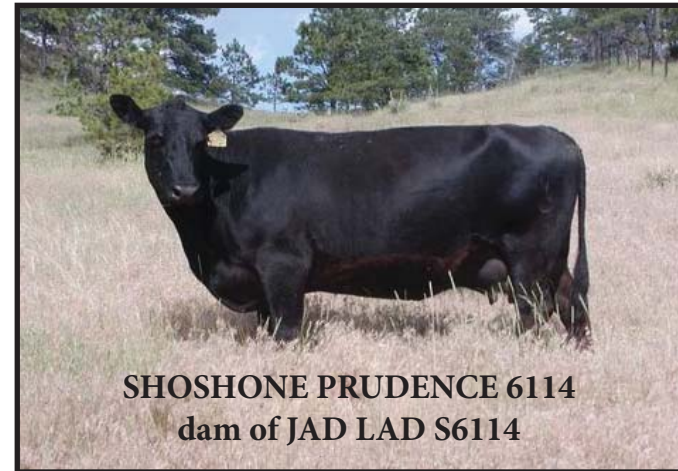

Full Rut 3 is co-owned with Pharo Cattle Co of Cheyenne Wells, CO and Todd and Jan Deatrich of Maywood, NE. We brought Full Rut 3 back into our herd because of the strength of his dam and grandam. They were good uddered cows that always produced calves with low birth weights and excellent performance. Full Rut 3 was just right as an individual. Moderate, easy fleshing, with good thickness, and correctness. He is siring less birth weight than his sire and the same pattern of muscle and volume with plenty of length. In 2007 we used 9 straws of semen and got 8 calves so he must have been fertile. Unfortunately he died unexpectedly after his first breeding season. Our semen supply is very limited.

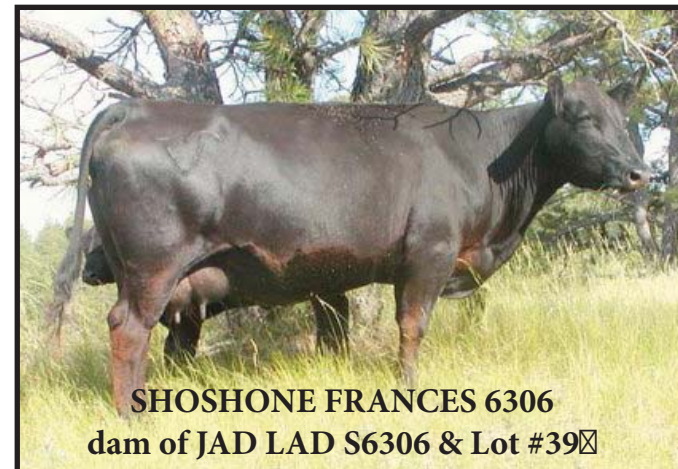

CALVING EASE

We are experiencing very little calving problems and it is my hope that the same will hold true for you, our customer. Our heifers calve right with our cows and they get checked twice a day just like the cows. Maternal calving ease is an important part of the equation and I believe we're on track to improve that in your herds through the daughters of our bulls. Additionally we have rated each bull on his predicted direct calving ease according to the following designations:

H1: This is the easiest calving designation in our system. These bulls will have low actual birth weight, negative birth EPD, low birth weight ancestry, and a phenotype indicative of calving ease which usually includes; less bone, smaller mature size, and earlier maturity. These bulls should be used where calving ease is a very high priority because the heifers don't get checked and/or the herd has a history of calving problems.

H2: These bulls are highly recommended for heifers. All the indicator traits and characteristics will be indicative of calving ease, just not to the same extreme as the H1 designated bulls.

H3: These bulls will work very well on heifers that are bigger framed, observed at calving or in situations where a bull needs to breed heifers for a few years and then move on to the cow herd. The total of their indicators may not be as consistent as either H1 or H2 designated bulls

C1: These bulls are to be used on cows that have already had one calf. I would never expect you to assist a cow at calving due to the birth weight of her calf by one of our bulls.
