I believe we all know inherently what excess muscle does to prolificacy. We are all well acquainted with what excess growth and size do to nutritional requirements and endocrine function. I think we all know the effects of different milk and carcass values on functional composition. And finally, many of us are now fully convinced that excess fleshing ease will decrease not improve fertility and longevity. So where does that leave us?

The conclusion I have come to is to select for functional efficiency or fitness in our environment with emphasis on excellence in maternal characteristics. Females do all the work on a ranch so it makes sense to actually select for the characteristics that allow them to do their job well and for a long time. Well adapted, fit animals perform well and on an efficiency basis are very competitive.

The result of our selection is a set of bulls, with high libido, that are active and move easily. They are nicely balanced and have proven their fitness in a low input nutritional environment. They are the “less problems more profit” kind. They are well represented all through this offering. My hope is that you will find and buy bulls that suit you and that they will reduce problems and increase function and adaptability in your herd and over time they will be a stable, maternal genetic influence that will increase your profit and your enjoyment level.

GENETIC DEFECTS: Every animal in this sale is free of known genetic defects by pedigree.

FERTILITY: Bulls have been fertility tested by Dr. John Gamby DVM and Dr. Rob Reid DVM on 11/3/2011.

DELIVERY: Free delivery first 500 miles, beyond 500 miles at cost. Delivery will occur as soon after the sale as arrangements can be made. Bring your own trailer and haul your own cattle and we will deduct \$50/Lot.

LIABILITY: Everyone attending the sale does so at their own responsibility and risk and without liability on the part of Dockweiler Angus or their employees.

INSPECTION: The cattle may be seen any time prior to the sale at the ranch. We will have the cattle available for inspection at the Dawes County Fair grounds by 10:00 AM the day of the sale.

RETAINED SEMEN INTEREST: John & Ann Dockweiler Angus is retaining a one-third revenue sharing semen interest on every bull listed in this catalog.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Our focus is the commercial rancher. His needs seem better served by our keeping costs down than by a registration certificate. Therefore most of the bulls have not been registered. If you want your bulls registered and transferred, please add \$100 to the purchase price and leave instructions with the clerk. Bulls listed as N/A in the catalog are not eligible for registration.

SALE: We will have all the sale cattle on site at the Dawes County Fairgrounds for your inspection. We will not bring the cattle into the sale area. Instead, we will play a video clip of each lot as it is being auctioned off. Our moderator will take bids in the order that he recognizes them proceeding until the bidding is stopped and the animal is sold.

ABSENTEE BIDDING: If you are unable to attend, contact us and we will work out a way for you to participate by phone or by leaving a bid. This sale is 100% transparent. If the bull sells you will know to whom and for how much. If the bull does not sell, you will know that too. There are absolutely no artificial price supports of any kind other than our floor of \$1800/bull. Rest assured that your absentee bid will not be misused in any way and your satisfaction upon delivery is guaranteed 100%.

GUARANTEE: The bulls have passed their semen test and are guaranteed to be able to service and settle cows.

CALVING EASE

Maternal calving ease is an important part of the equation and I believe we're on track to improve that in your herds through the daughters of our bulls. Additionally, we have rated each bull on his predicted direct calving ease according to the following designations:

H1: This is the easiest calving designation in our system. These bulls will have low actual birth weight, negative birth EPD, low birth weight ancestry, and a phenotype indicative of calving ease which usually includes; less bone, smaller mature size, and earlier maturity. These bulls should be used where calving ease is a very high priority because the heifers don't get checked and/or the herd has a history of calving problems.

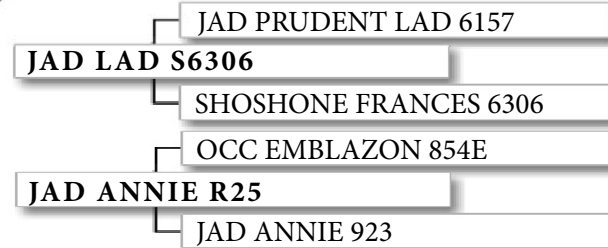
H2: These bulls are highly recommended for heifers. All the indicator traits and characteristics will be indicative of calving ease, just not to the same extreme as the H1 designated bulls.

H3: These bulls will work very well on heifers that are bigger framed, observed at calving or in situations where a bull needs to breed heifers for a few years and then move on to the cow herd. The total of their indicators may not be as consistent as either H1 or H2 designated bulls

C1: These bulls are to be used on cows that have already had one calf. I would never expect you to assist a cow at calving due to the birth weight of her calf by one of our bulls.
