SALE: The sale will be held at the Dawes County Fairgrounds at 1:00 MST on Friday, December 3, 2021.

VIEWING: Bulls will be located at 215 Pineview Rd., Chadron, NE. They will be penned for easy viewing from 9:00 – 11:30 AM MST on Friday Dec. 3. Videos will be linked on the website prior to the opening day.

PARTICIPATION: Three options:

1. Come look through the bulls and make your selections. Then join us at the fairgrounds at 1:00 MST. **You can offer your bid** as we proceed through the sale order.
2. Notify us of which lots you are interested in and we will call you when that bull is being sold. **You can bid live via telephone.**
3. Leave your order with Ann or I and we will **have someone bid in your absence.**

All bulls will be base priced at \$2500. If two or more are interested in a bull, we will raise the bid in \$250 increments until the bull is sold. If you are the only person interested in the bull you may buy him at the base price.

Whether you attend in person, are on the phone, or leave your bid: this sale is conducted in a straightforward, transparent manner. Bids are never misused in any way and your trust is of utmost importance to us.

SEMEN INTEREST: John & Ann Dockweiler Angus will retain a semen interest on every bull selling.

DELIVERY: The first 150 miles is free, remainder at cost.

HEALTH: All bulls will have passed a semen test. The non-virgin bulls will be tested free of trichomoniasis.

GUARANTEE: The bulls are guaranteed breeders. If they aren't, return them and we will stand behind them 100%. Beyond that, we offer no guarantee against injury or death.

FOOD: Ann will have coffee and rolls at the bull pens in the morning and will serve lunch at the fairgrounds.

LIABILITY: Anyone attending the sale does so at their own responsibility and risk, without liability on the part of the owners.



It's been another challenging year; and more so for many of you than what we have experienced here in northwest Nebraska. I decided to send these bulls to Travis Denton's backgrounding lot for the summer. Having solved that problem, I sent all the yearling heifers a few weeks later. Travis and family did an excellent job feeding and caring for our yearlings. We were blessed with some late rains and have some grass left to graze. Unfortunately feed costs are through the roof and hay, if you can find it, is near double the inflated 2020 rates. But, like a true rancher, I think if we can get through this winter, and if it rains, things will look good again next year.

Thank you for your continued interest in our maternal Angus breeding program. I have used simple, known genetic principles to establish a good type of cow for our environment. I long ago quit dictating what size she would be, how much fat she would carry, how much calf she should wean and on and on and on. Instead, I let the cows tell me what they can and can't do and what they should and shouldn't be. The result has been increasing harmony, decreasing cull rates, increasing consistency and renewability. I'm not at war with my cows. I'm not trying to force them or cull them to be or do anything. They simply are what they are and do what they do, and I'm satisfied, no, actually quite pleased, with what they have become, which is simply middle of the road, average cattle. Not much of a brag, but middle of the road cattle are increasingly hard to find and the only kind that I have been able to successfully linebreed over time.

This all came about from years of observing, and trying, and failing to accomplish any true, lasting, maternal genetic merit. During that time, I would sit at the table eating lunch and a group of White-Tailed does and fawns would come through the yard. No one was recording any weaning weights, or putting pressure on frame size, or fleshing ability or culling out the undesirables, but there they were as efficient as could be, dragging along twins and big singles while maintaining themselves. Uniform, refined, and beautifully fit for their function and environment.

I was amazed and humbled by the Creator's wisdom as a breeder of White-Tailed deer. It made sense to breed primarily from within with just an occasional outcross to uphold diversity. I decided to use lots of males and let them compete to mate in order to uphold soundness, vigor, and fertility. The females are naturally fertile, frugal, and prolific, with a kind, nurturing, maternally intelligent disposition. This is a simple, low-cost, low-risk, and I must say, high reward breeding philosophy.

I still fool around with the side hustles of A.I. and E.T. but the above briefly describes the overall philosophy that has produced a functional, uniform, renewable herd of cows that perform well in our environment. Their sons, that we are offering in this sale, are designed to deliver those same characteristics into your herd.
